Throughout the course of the 9th grade we will study the evolution of World History from the origins of civilization through the Age of Revolutions (1750 CE). In addition to history, we will also focus on geography and several important themes such as social, political and economic systems. Along with the content, special attention will be dedicated to reading, writing, speaking, listening, thinking, and study skills. At the end of this year, there will be a Final Exam. Our primary goal is that students successfully complete this course by demonstrating their abilities to: read and comprehend complex historical text, think critically, and express themselves in writing,

<u>Tests</u> – Worth **55%** of the total class grade

- Unit tests will be given in multiple choice and essay formats
- Each Unit Test will consist of questions regarding information from multiple textbook chapters, classwork and supplemental materials.

- Classwork will be evaluated on a daily basis and will count as a TEST GRADE for each quarter

Quizzes – Worth 25% of total class grade

- Quizzes will be administered on a regular basis
- All quizzes will be noted on the monthly course calendar
- Ouizzes will be based on chapter readings, class activities and supplemental materials

Homework – Worth 20% of total class grade

- Homework will be assigned weekly throughout the year
- Homework calendars will be posted ONLINE at the beginning of each month
